## **Checklist for your application**

### **Step 1:** To apply, make sure...

- you are working on doctoral (Ph.D.) or postdoctoral project (*Habilitation*/ second book) that is supervised at a Bavarian university;
- your research for this project is situated in a discipline represented in the Bavarian American Academy, preferably in the fields of history, political sciences, sociology, economics, law, area studies, geography, American literary and cultural studies, art, or art history.
- you have identified specific materials in the Library of Congress's collection that are useful for your independent research project and have not been digitized.

### **Step 2:** To receive the proposal form, please send in...

- your curriculum vitae.

### **Step 3:** After receiving the proposal form, please send in...

- the filled out proposal form.
- a letter of recommendation from your doctoral advisor or your supervisor for your postgraduate project.
- a documentation of attainment of your master's degree (or equivalent) or Ph.D.

### **Formalities:**

- Your application materials must be in English.
- Your application must be submitted as a single PDF-file.
- Application deadline: **February 15, 2024**
