Checklist for your application

Step 1: To apply, make sure you have...

- a master's degree (or equivalent) or a Ph.D. from a Bavarian university.
- a research interest preferably in the fields of history, political sciences, sociology, law, economics, area studies, American literature and culture studies for your doctor's degree, or your postgraduate project (*Habilitation*/second book).
- identified specific materials in the Library of Congress's collection that are useful for your independent research project and not digitalized.

Step 2: To receive the proposal form, please send in...

- your curriculum vitae.

Step 3: After receiving the proposal form, please send in...

- the filled out proposal form.
- a letter of recommendation from your doctoral advisor, or your supervisor for your postgraduate project.
- a documentation of attainment of your master's degree (or equivalent).

Formalities:

- Your application must be in English.
- Your application must be sent as one single PDF-file.
- Application deadline: For the year 2022, the selection process has already been completed and the fellowships have been awarded. You will find the calls for applications for the year 2023 on our websites by November 2022.
