Yale University Post-Graduate Research Fellowship

The Bavarian American Academy and the Yale Club of Germany, e.V. invite scholars to apply for a graduate research fellowship at the Gilder Lehrman Center for the Study of Slavery, Resistance, and Abolition for summer/fall 2021.

Candidates: We welcome candidates especially from the disciplines of history, political sciences, sociology, area studies, American literature and culture studies. Applicants should be at the doctoral level.

Fellows will be awarded **2,000 €** for their travel and accommodation costs. Fellows will have the opportunity to research in different libraries and engage in academic exchange. Work space will be provided.

The fellowship is a short time stipend and usually supports the candidate for a stay up to 6 weeks at Yale University. Organizational help for housing, etc. will be provided.

- A curriculum vitae
- A project description no longer than 2 pages
- A letter of recommendation from doctoral advisor
